## Glynn Cox



Before completing my 37 year Customizing Engineering career with Bell Helicopter, I attempted some turning without much success. At the top of my post-retirement bucket list was to learn to turn properly. A class with Stuart Batty implanted the bug and the rest is history.

I am currently president of the Woodturners Of North Texas and a member of Golden Triangle Woodturners.

I enjoy turning hollow form vessels from burls and rough wood. I rarely use color, preferring to let the wood's natural grain texture enhance the piece.

In the last few years I have been making thin wall turnings and piercing them using high speed dental type tools. Creating beautiful patterns with piercing is not for every turner as it takes a steady hand, a lot of patience and can be expensive.

This demonstration, Piercing On The Cheap, is not about actual piercing, which is like watching paint dry, it rather details a method of getting started in piercing for about 100 dollars. This is assuming you have an adequate air compressor. I will discuss the various types of piercing tools, their associated uses and drawbacks. Very high speed low cost dental type hand-pieces will be introduced illustrating their advantages and disadvantages. I will build a filter-regulator assembly, including tubing, gauge and valve options. This regulator can be used for introductory or professional piercing tools as well as air brushing. Various burs for cutting and texturing will be discussed and, time permitting, pattern transfer and some actual piercing will be demonstrated

## Empty Bowls of Denton


Join us for the 2015 Empty Bowls Luncheon!
