
Spoon Turning Material List Neal Brand January 2021

Wood blanks: 1" x 2 7/8" x 12" marked 4 inches from end. I prefer hard maple.

Hollowing chuck:

- Beall 8" Buffing Extender (Available at most stores with woodturning supplies for approximately \$26.)
- 2" x 3" x 6" drilled blank (Any wood, I used two 2 by 4's glued together.
- 2 3" x 5" U bolts (Available at bolt suppliers. I only found 6 inch, so I cut off 1 inch.)
- 2" 3/8" 16 tpi bolt
- Washer to fit bolt



2 in x 3 in x 6 in block

Safety shield 3" x 3" thin square (plastic or wood). Corners drilled for small screws. Center drilled for hollowing entrance.

Live center attachment. Make to fit threads of your live center. Two slots 3/16" wide, one with one edge at center, the other centered at $\frac{1}{2}$ " off center of attachment.

Inflatable round sander is very helpful. (Available online at Amazon, Rockler, Woodcraft and other vendors of woodturning supplies.)

Belt or disk sander. Can use lathe to make a disk sander.

Standard spindle turning and hollowing tools.
